



ASX Announcement InfoMaster awarded Local Government Association of Queensland Contract

The Board of Sirius Corporation Ltd (ASX:SIU) is pleased to announce that InfoMaster Pty Ltd (InfoMaster), a wholly owned subsidiary of Sirius Corporation Limited, has been awarded a contract for the installation of Electronic Development Assessment (eDA) software by the Local Government Association of Queensland (LGAQ). The contract is valued at \$520,000.00 and is to be delivered by 30 June 2010.

This project is the second InfoMaster project to kick off in South East Queensland (SEQ) from the Queensland Housing Affordability Fund Electronic Development Assessment programme (HAF-eDA).

The objective of the HAF-eDA is the delivery of a seamless, comprehensive and integrated electronic development assessment process in key high growth councils across Queensland to contribute towards improved housing affordability.

Executive Director of LGAQ Mr Greg Hallam said "that through the delivery of this contract the quality of applications will improve substantially. Required information becomes more apparent, reducing application revisions and providing assessors with the information required by them to commence their process of determination. The software encourages the provision of a good quality application by guiding an applicant through a process that better aligns the output with the relevant council criteria. Information requests will be reduced and assessments will be more consistent along with shorter processing times. The relationship between council, industry and home owners will improve as will the interaction with state interest groups who require access to applications that impact their particular area".

Group Managing Director Mr Frank Licciardello said that "this contract builds on the relationship between LGAQ and InfoMaster which formed during earlier projects. In August this year LGAQ worked together with InfoMaster to deliver an eDA solution for Fraser Coast Regional Council that provided application tracking, on line land use queries and comprehensive business reporting tools. This successful project was the first eDA initiative to be funded under the 2008 Housing Affordability Fund launched by the Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs (FaHCSIA). We look forward to delivering an excellent solution for SEQ councils and continuing to lead ePlanning in Australia."

Geoff Reeves, General Manager of InfoMaster said "this project is an exciting addition to work we are undertaking with councils with ePlanning. Our MasterView and MasterPlan products integrate with core systems and increase the ability for councils to provide high demand services on line to their customers. InfoMaster helps to get people out of line and on line, which resonates with HAF nationally."
