Department Transport and Main Roads Queensland upgrades AssetMaster Contract to full site licence

The Board of Sirius Corporation Ltd (ASX:SIU) is pleased to announce that InfoMaster, a wholly owned subsidiary of Sirius, has received notice to extend the software license at the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Queensland to a full site license. A \$300,000 additional fee will provide unlimited use of the AssetMaster software product for the department. The announcement of the initial sale was made to the market on 25 March 2009 when it was advised that InfoMaster had successfully bid to win a competitive tender for the supply and implementation of an Asset Information and Management system. The first part of the deployment included a 20-user license installation, to be followed by an extension to a full site license.

The initial deployment phase has been completed and rolled out to 18 sites across Queensland. The application is now used to manage over 43,000 road lights, 30,000 traffic signals and other associated transport system and electrical assets that form part of the department's \$53 billion in road and infrastructure assets.

Following the integration of the former departments of Queensland Transport and Main Roads to form a single entity, the Department of Transport and Main Roads (DTMR), additional users are seeking to access the AssetMaster system. The inclusion of busways, tunnels and bus stations as part of the new \$333m Inner Northern Busway in Brisbane and the Tugun Bypass will allow AssetMaster to record a wider variety of equipment along with its maintenance and service activities.

Sirius Group Managing Director Mr Frank Licciardello said "This is fantastic news for InfoMaster. Our asset management software was designed for enterprise deployment and we welcome the opportunity to work with DTMR as they expand their use and extract more functionality from the system."

Susan McLaws, Project Manager for DTMR's Road System Information Program said, "The software will assist the Department of Transport and Main Roads in the management of risk (including environmental risks), asset works, scheduled maintenance and performance monitoring as well as providing a continuing record of appropriate technical standards and remediation history. It will also aid with the long-term development of asset and financial management strategies and will directly support the achievement of Transport and Main Roads' strategic priorities aligned with Queensland Government objectives in "Toward Q2: Tomorrow's Queensland" ".
