InfoMaster awarded Department of Main Roads, Queensland Tender

The board of Sirius Corporation Ltd (ASX:SIU) is pleased to announce that Infomaster, a wholly owned subsidiary of Sirius, has been awarded a competitive tender to supply and implement an Asset Maintenance software system to the Department of Main Roads, Queensland. The system will provide a state-wide solution expected to be installed over 18 sites throughout Queensland. The contract value is for \$585K, for a period of three years with an option to extend for three one year periods. We estimate delivery and installations to commence before June 2009.

Group Managing Director Mr Frank Licciardello said this was a major win for Infomaster. Although the Infomaster asset solution is well known and used by many Local Government Authorities, this is the first sale to a State Government department. Infomaster's system moreover was successful against strong competition from larger, multi-national software companies. This demonstrates that the company's AssetMaster System is being increasingly acknowledged in the market as a proven specialist solution for the management of State and Local Government infrastructure assets. The win will assist Infomaster in further developing its solution not only for infrastructure and water assets but also large road assets.

The solution Infomaster offered was its AssetMaster product, {www.infomaster.com.au}. The product is built on a single software platform and delivers the most comprehensive view of all asset types across an entire enterprise. AssetMaster provides a clear picture of where cost savings can be made and helps to reduce the total cost of ownership. It also features financial integration, spatial decision support, and predictive modelling – features that have been overlooked in many Asset Management systems in the past.

The software will assist Queensland Main Roads to better manage risk (including environmental risks) and will aid with the long-term development of asset and financial management strategies.

It is expected that the solution will be delivered to council over the next 6-12 months, commencing with some detailed scoping, in the next 30 days.

The Queensland Department of Main Roads joins a growing list of customers such as Coffs Harbour City Council, Richmond Valley City Council, City of Melbourne, Timbercorp, Central Goldfields, Marrickville and Gold Coast City Council, to name a few, that are currently receiving benefits from the use of this technology.
